

Rusalka to perform folk songs, dances

Rusalka, a Slavic folk group from Ohio State University, will perform Russian and Eastern European folk songs and dances at 7 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 14, in Souers Recital Hall, Center for Performing Arts.

Rusalka was founded in 1984 as an offshoot of a course titled "Music in Russian Folk Tradition." Its members include OSU students, faculty and staff, as well as Columbus-area residents. They have toured throughout Ohio and upstate New York.
